ARTIST'S STATEMENT

The Artist's Statement should specifically address the work's relationship to the theme. There should be a separate statement for each work submitted.

The Jurors will give each artist's statement serious consideration as it often gives important insight into the artist's ideas and engagement. Final decisions regarding winners have often come down to the quality of the statement and the thinking that it reveals. As such, they should be well written, with correct spelling and grammar. We recommend that you have someone proof and/or provide input on your text before you submit your final version. Submitted statements are required to be "exhibition ready," as they will be displayed along with your artwork. The corresponding statements from winning works will be published online, and potentially read aloud at the time the works are presented to the Sadat Lecture for Peace speaker (e.g., the Dalai Lama in 2013). It is, therefore, important that that you present yourself in a professional manner.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY:

In order to ensure that all statements are presented in a uniform layout, please include the following information when you submit your statement via email: name, media, year of completion, and title of work. Please include this on top of your artist statement.
